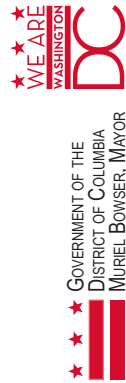

Protect Your Child with Regular Checkups

As part of your DC Healthy Families benefits, your child’s medical and dental checkups are FREE from birth until your child turns 21. If the doctor finds a problem during a checkup, you can get treatment for your child using your DC Healthy Families benefits.

Medical Checkups

Protect your child by having them get a complete physical at the ages shown in this table.

Infancy and First Year	Early Childhood	Late Childhood	Teen and Young Adult
1 month	15 months	5 years	Once per year from ages 11 years through 20 years

Immunizations (Shots)

Your child can be given shots that will protect against many serious diseases. Make appointments for your child to be immunized at the following ages:


- Birth to 2 months
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 12 to 24 months
- 4 to 6 years
- 11 to 14 years
- 15 years
- 16 to 18 years

Dental Checkups

HealthCheck also provides FREE dental services to children up to age 21. Make an appointment for a dental exam for your child every six months after his or her third birthday.

If you are pregnant or a new mom and are not in a health plan

- Call your Social Services worker at **(202) 724-5506** to get your new baby a Medicaid card



What Your HealthCheck Benefits Include

Medical Services

- Eye and hearing checkups
- Eyeglasses and hearing aids
- Health education
- Immunizations (shots)
- Mental health screening and services
- Prenatal care
- Substance abuse counseling or referral
- Testing for sickle cell anemia
- Testing for too much contact with lead (done at 12 and 24 months and additionally when a child is found to be at risk)
- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted disease (STD)

Dental Services

In addition to free checkups every six months, your child may also be eligible for the following free dental services:

- Basic dental treatment
- X-rays
- Instruction on how to care for mouth and teeth
- Dental sealants
- Fluoride treatment
- Limited orthodontic services
- Filling and tooth extraction

Early Testing and Assistance for Developmentally Challenged Children

DC Child Find assistance is available if you are worried that your child:

- Learns new skills like sitting up, crawling, or throwing balls more slowly than other children who are the same age
- Doesn’t do things for herself as early as other children do
- Has difficulty learning or speaking
- Becomes more upset than other children when in new places or circumstances

Depending upon your child’s age, call:

- 0-3 years: **(202) 727-5847**
- 3-5 years and not enrolled in school: **(202) 671-0882**
- Enrolled in school: Your child’s school

Using Your HealthCheck Benefits

- Call your doctor or clinic to schedule medical checkups.
- Call your dentist or the Dental Health Line at **(866) 758-6807** to schedule dental checkups.
- Bring the member ID card issued to your child by your health plan to every appointment.
- For questions about how to enroll in a health plan, call **(202) 639-4030**.
- To get transportation to your child’s HealthCheck visits, call your health plan. If you are not in a plan, call the Medical Management Transport Line at **(866) 796-0601**.
